

13 Business Leaders Named The Entrepreneur of the Year 2025

Singapore, 30 September 2025 – 13 local entrepreneurs were announced as Winners of The Entrepreneur of the Year Award (EYA) 2025 at the Award Certificate Ceremony today. Of these, eight entrepreneurs were Winners of the Established Entrepreneur category and five entrepreneurs were Winners of the New Entrepreneur category.

The EYA is one of Singapore's most established business accolades showcasing entrepreneurs on a platform of national scale. The EYA is currently in its 35th year of honouring and celebrating the achievements of local entrepreneurs.
